I. **Call to Order**

II. **Meeting Minutes**

III. **Public Comment on Items Not on the Agenda:**

There were no public comments on items not on the agenda.

IV. **Confirm Land Use Alternatives**

General Plan Consultant Dave Amos presented the three land use alternative concepts, including land use designations and land use diagrams, to the GPAC. After a brief discussion, GPAC members voted to confirm each of the land use designations. GPAC members then discussed the three land use alternative concepts. The GPAC confirmed Alternative 1, the existing General Plan, with no discussion. In the discussion of Alternative 2, Orderly Growth, GPAC member Muniz proposed an amendment to increase the size of focus area 9 and designate the new land south of the Gilroy Sports Park with an urban designation. The GPAC voted to approve that amendment. The GPAC then voted to confirm Alternative 2. The GPAC confirmed Alternative 3, Compact Growth, with little discussion. After the votes, Dave Amos gave a brief presentation on the Growth Management policies that could accompany the three alternatives.

V. Alternatives Process Next Steps

General Plan Consultant Dave Amos presented the Alternatives timeline to the GPAC. This presentation included a brief discussion of the process so far and the steps yet to come. The GPAC received the presentation and took no action.
